The Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina (UFSC) has its main campus located in Florianópolis, capital of the state of Santa Catarina, Brazil.

FLORIANÓPOLIS

Florianópolis is the capital and second largest city in Santa Catarina state. It is also known by its nickname "Floripa".

This magic city has the third highest Human Development Index score in Brazil. It offers the comfort of a developed urban center while maintaining its intimate contact with nature. Sea, hillsides and more than 40 beaches are all nestled in a breathtaking landscape. Most of the city lies on the long, slender Santa Catarina Island, which is 54 km long and 18 km wide. The city's population, according to the 2017 IBGE population estimate, is 485.838. Tourism forms the basis of the local economy, causing the population to triple during summer months.

The city's economy is also heavily based on technology and services.
